

European Quiznight

The idea behind the European Quiznight is to bring young people from all across Europe together in an interactive, informative and fun format. As Eurodesk Karlsruhe, we host the event in cooperation with other partners all across Europe, e.g. Europe Direct Centres, Eurodesk multipliers, the European Parliament Ambassador Schools and the European Parliament's togetherfor.eu campaign.

Young people between the age of 15 and 30 from all European countries can take part in the European Quiznight. The quiz itself is organised online, lasts approximately two hours and is always held in English to enable anyone with a basic knowledge of the language to participate. It includes questions about Europe in categories such as geography, politics, history, culture, society and youth mobility as well a picture and music round, in which the teams have to guess the language the song is sung in.

The participants are divided into teams of around five people from different countries. After each of the four rounds of questions, the teams are able to meet in breakout sessions. Here, the participants do not only have time to discuss their answers, but also have the chance to get to know each other and their countries, which is what the event is all about. More than 360 young people took part in the European Quiznight between 2023-2025.
